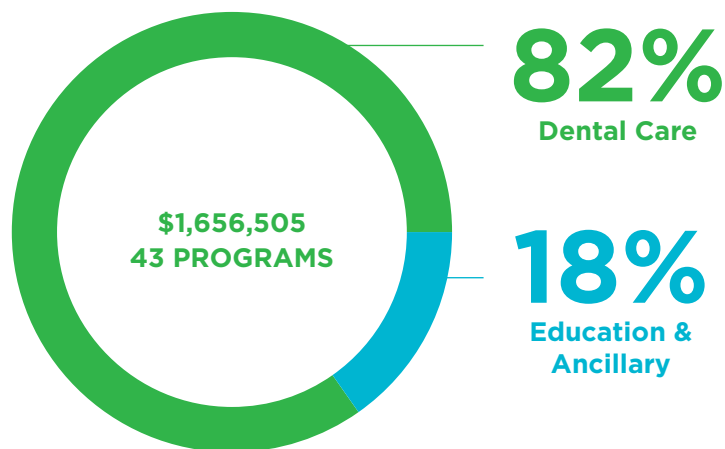


As a not-for-profit dental benefits company, Delta Dental of Oklahoma's mission is to improve the oral health of all Oklahomans. Through the Delta Dental of Oklahoma Foundation, Delta Dental invests in programs committed to oral health education and access to dental care throughout the state.

For 2018, Delta Dental of Oklahoma (DDOK) contributed \$1,656,505* to 43 programs, with 82 percent of this funding dedicated to providing dental treatment to underserved and vulnerable populations. A complete list of grant recipients is available on the last page of this report.

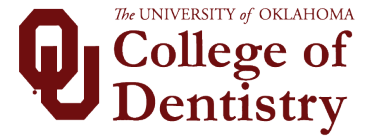
ADDITIONAL DENTAL CARE INITIATIVES

Pre-Dentistry Endowed Scholarships

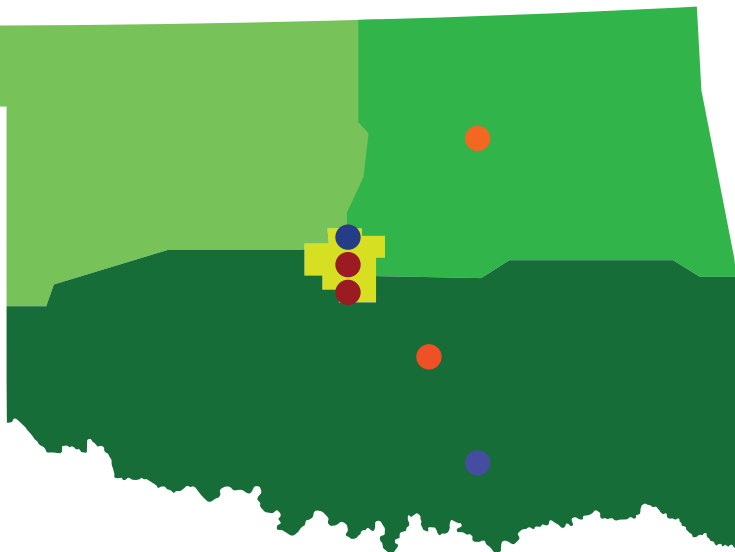
We proudly support undergraduate students planning to enter the profession of dentistry by providing annual pre-dentistry scholarships at several state universities.
