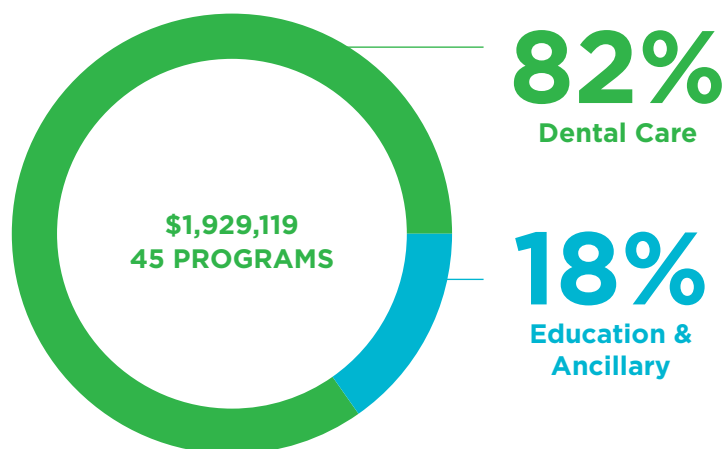


As a not-for-profit dental benefits company, Delta Dental of Oklahoma's mission is to improve the oral health of all Oklahomans. Through the Delta Dental of Oklahoma Foundation, Delta Dental invests in programs committed to oral health education and access to dental care throughout the state.

For 2020, Delta Dental of Oklahoma (DDOK) contributed \$1,929,119\* to 45 programs, with 82 percent of this funding dedicated to providing dental treatment to underserved and vulnerable populations. A complete list of grant recipients is available on the last page of this report.



## Grants to Free Clinics & Programs

In 2020, DDOK Foundation awarded **\$1,212,850** in grants to clinics and programs that provide free dental care to underserved and vulnerable populations. The COVID-19 Pandemic, including the cessation of all but emergency dental treatment for several weeks, constrained the amount of dental treatment that could be delivered, but our funding aided our grantee organizations as they served the vital needs of our communities.

## COVID-19 Pandemic Dental Emergency Response Program

In 2020, DDOK Foundation launched a new program to divert dental patients from hospital emergency departments (EDs) during the COVID-19 Pandemic. Our Dental Care Navigators helped connect patients to the best resources for their needs. Our Dental Emergency Fund covered the costs required to help qualifying, low-income patients access treatment.

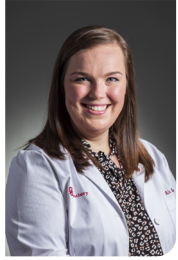
### Resource for Dental Care Guide

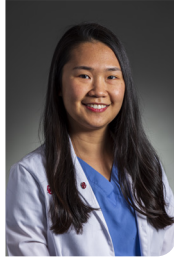

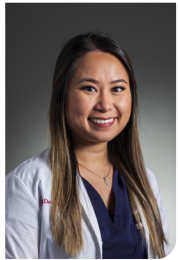
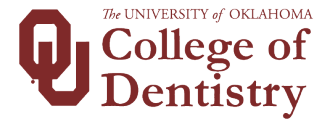

### Pre-Dentistry Endowed Scholarships

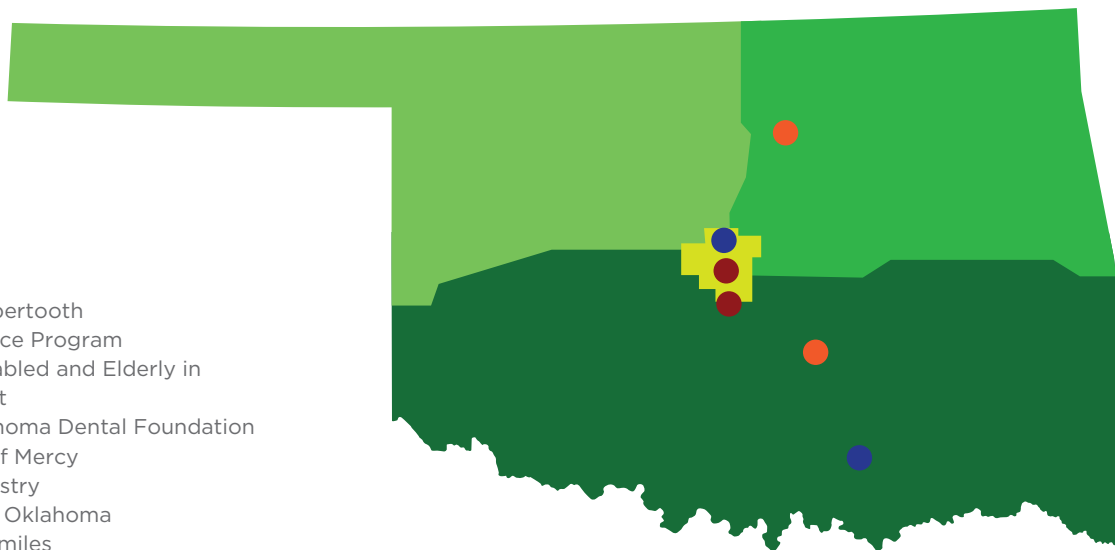
We proudly support undergraduate students planning to enter the profession of dentistry by providing annual pre-dentistry scholarships at several state universities.
